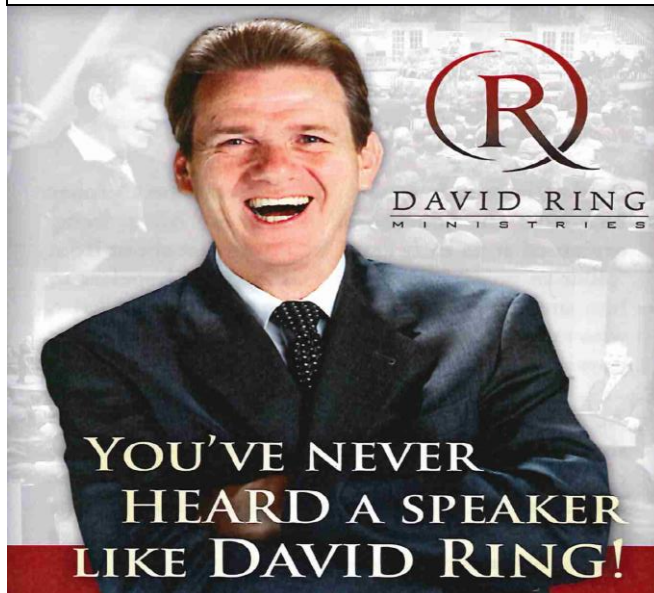
Dear South Avenue Baptist Church,
