Bethany Class Business Meeting

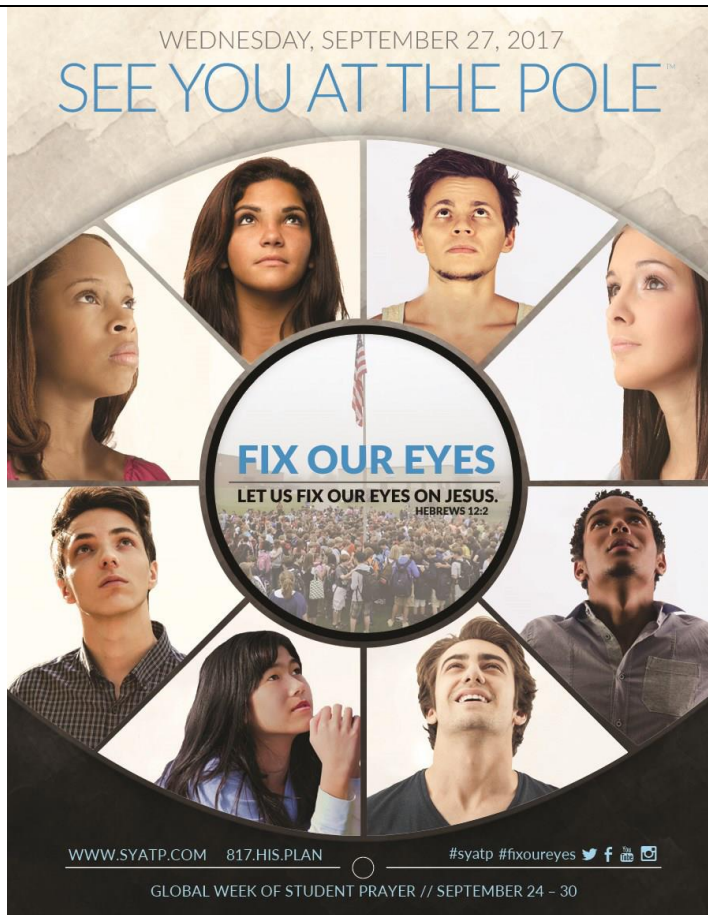
